\*The Chairman of Stewards advised Trainer Terence Evans that Lynrowan would be an unsuitable ride for Apprentice J Lambie and gave permission for Apprentice Y Nishitani to replace him on the colt.

\*\*\*Explanations were accepted from Trainers Paul E Jones and David & Scott Brunton regarding riders for their horses today due to the shortage of riders.

### **RACE 1 – CEREBAL PALSY TASMANIA SUPERVOBIS 2YO HANDICAP – 1100 METRES**

Lynrowan jumped awkwardly bumping with Silver Strike.

Lynrowan (Y Nishitani (a)) commenced to over-race at approximately the 800 metres and as a result the colt had to be steadied by its rider.

Tiger Won't Tell and Titus Flavius both hung in under pressure over the concluding stages.

Stewards questioned Jockey B McCoull (Silver Strike) regarding the filly's poor performance today. Jockey McCoull stated that the filly jumped well but when placed under pressure, failed to respond. Trainer M Trinder stated that the filly had had some six weeks between races and would be better suited at its next start. A post-race veterinary inspection of Silver Strike failed to reveal any abnormalities.

***Stewards downgraded the track to DEAD (5) at 12.41 pm***

### **RACE 2 – KINGBOROUGH RESOURCE RECOVERY CENTRE SUPERVOBIS 3YO MAIDEN SET WEIGHTS – 1100 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey J Hamer to ride Live to Win ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey B McCoull to ride Polperro ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Suspicious Geegee and Slightly Ticklish both jumped awkwardly.

Light Frost was slow to begin.

Stewards questioned Apprentice J Riordan (March Again) as to the reasons why he elected to stay wide on the track throughout the event. Apprentice Riordan stated that after beginning from a wide gate, his mount was inclined to hang out and as a result he elected to stay in a wide position as he believed that was the better part of the track.

A post-race veterinary inspection of March Again revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer George Blacker was advised that he must tender a veterinary certificate of soundness before March Again's next race start.

### **RACE 3 – SEMF SUPERVOBIS 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1200 METRES**

Golden Frau was hampered at the start between Underbelly and Just A Gee Gee.

At approximately the 200 metres Red Jaffa was momentarily hampered when Savior shifted wider on the track.

At approximately the 200 metres Ebony And Emerald shifted in when under pressure.

Gleaming laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

Jockey E Brennen pleaded guilty under AR 144 in that he failed to weigh in on Underbelly after being placed second. After taking into account Jockey Brennen's guilty plea and the fact that he had never been spoken to previously in relation to this rule, Jockey Brennen was fined the sum of \$100.

### **RACE 4 – TOTE TASMANIA MAIDEN / CLASS 1 – SET WEIGHTS – 1600 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey K Sanderson to ride Troyana ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Samsonic was slow to begin and was unable to muster early speed.

Shortly after the start Chilsun had to be momentarily steadied off the heels of Here's Shifty.

At approximately the 1200 metres Amazing Pace began to over-race and as a result had to be steadied by its rider.

At approximately the 1200 metres Jockey E Brennen (Miss Margate) had to momentarily take hold when Our Lady of Light (R Tremsal) shifted in. Stewards reminded Jockey Tremsal of his obligations when shifting ground.

Miss Margate and Amazing Pace were held up from the 500 metres until approximately the 400 metres.

### **RACE 5 - SAFETY & FIRE EQUIPMENT SERVICES 0-75 HANDICAP – 2100 METRES**

Jockey B McCoull pleaded guilty and was fined \$100 under AR 120(b) in that he was overweight and unable to take his ride on Gurlion. .

Stewards granted permission for Jockey J Hamer to ride Portland Miss ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Smith to ride Tismore ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Gurlion stood flat-footed and as a result was slow to begin.

Tismore over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

### **RACE 6 - GOVERNOR'S CUP OPEN HANDICAP – 1100 METRES**

Centenary Diamond underwent a veterinary examination prior to the start and the gelding was passed fit to take its place with the field.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Smith to ride Granite Hill ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey M Munday to ride Jackmelad ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey K Sanderson to ride Stadacona ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Strategist was slow to begin.

Conquering jumped away awkwardly.

Approaching the winning post Conquering had to be momentarily steadied off heels when Jackmelad shifted in under pressure.

### **RACE 7 – HAZEL BROS CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES**

Palzago and Trustee were both slow into stride.

Approaching the 1100 metres Royal Oncology had to be steadied off heels when Tough Future rolled out marginally.

Jockey L Smith (Palzago) reported that he lost his nearside iron over the concluding stages.

### **RACE 8 - FEDERAL GROUP CLASS 4 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Coffey to ride Racy Damon ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey B McCoull to ride Brodie's Boy ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey J Hamer to ride King of Gondor ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Bayou Senja jumped awkwardly and as a result the gelding was slow to begin.

At approximately the 100 metres Bayou Senja and World Beater bumped when Bayou Senja was taking a tight run between World Beater and the outside running rail.
