### ***Comments / Explanations:***

***Jockey J Hamer was fined \$100 under AR 120(b) in that he was overweight and unable to take his ride on King Of Gondor in Race 7.***

### **RACE 1 – SPIRIT TRAVEL AND TOURS SUPERVOBIS 2YO MAIDEN PLATE – 1000 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey M Guthrie to ride Incat ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey M Munday to ride Last Laga Waltz ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Big Sauce and Stylist Spirit bumped on jumping.

At approximately the 600 metres Big Sauce was inclined to hang out and continued to do so rounding the home turn.

After making the crossing near the 200 metres Stylish Spirit appeared to resent the whip and shifted in abruptly.

Incat laid in under pressure in the home straight.

### **RACE 2 – DRC STUD TOUR 2010 SUPERVOBIS 3YO MAIDEN PLATE – 1000 METRES**

The start was delayed approximately 4 minutes when Slightly Ticklish lost her near hind shoe. Following consultation with connections and the jockey, when the farrier could not replat the filly Slightly Ticklish underwent a pre race veterinary examination and was permitted to race bare foot behind. A post race veterinary examination of Slightly Ticklish revealed no obvious abnormalities.

What A Liberty was fractious in the barriers. Stable Foreman Michael Voss representing Trainer C Goggin was advised that What A Liberty must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again.

Master Alan, Talavera and La Pampa were all slow into stride.

Miss Squirtles raced ungenerously at approximately the 600 metres.

Apprentice J Lambie was reprimanded under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used the whip in a forehand position on six (6) occasions prior to the 100 metres which is one (1) more than the permitted number.

Cool Tele shifted in abruptly at approximately the 100 metres when resenting the use of the whip.

Jockey E Brennan was examined by the ambulance officers after he injured his right hand in the barriers. Jockey Brennan was advised to seek precautionary Xrays as soon as possible.

### **RACE 3 – BOAGS DRAUGHT SUPERVOBIS 3YO & UP MAIDEN PLATE – 1175 METRES**

Red Jaffa was a late scratching at 9.51 am by order of Stewards when Trainer Paul Jones advised that he was unaware the horse had gained a run.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey B McCoull to ride Polperro ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Descimedes jumped awkwardly and was slow to muster early speed.

Racing to the 700 metres March Again had to be steadied off the heels of Deludor when that gelding shifted in away from Captainmacgaw.

At approximately the 600 metres Three Dancers and Deludor were momentarily hampered when racing tight between Captainmacgaw and Stylist Geegee.

Near the 600 metres Chainlocker (M Guthrie) had to steady and take hold when Polperro (B McCoull) shifted out and Matsangel (R Tremsal) shifted in marginally. Jockey R Tremsal was reminded of his obligations when shifted ground.

At approximately the 150 metres Three Dancers shifted in under pressure bumping with Deludor.

A post race veterinary examination of Polperro revealed no obvious abnormalities.

### **RACE 4 – SUNDAY EXAMINER CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1000 METRES**

Sir Lugana was declared a late scratching at 12.41pm by order of Stewards acting on veterinary advice when the gelding cast a shoe and a nail penetrated the near fore sole. Prior to the announcement of correct weight, Stewards ordered all monies invested on Sir Lugano to be refunded in full and all bets made prior to 12.41 pm to be paid less three cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less four cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. Stable Foreman S Carr representing Trainer R Carr was advised that he must produce a veterinary certificate before Sir Lugano races again.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey M Guthrie to ride Fish ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Royal Oncology jumped inwards at the start bumping with Lord Aspinall who lost ground as a result.

Near the 600 metres Lord Aspinall shifted ground outwards taking Montel wider on the track.

Taiyin was held up near the 600 metres to approximately the home turn.

At approximately the 450 metres Beautiful Fantasy shifted ground outwards when trying to obtain a clear run from behind Costas Me Grandee and as a result bumped with Lord Aspinall.

Jockey S Brazil (Montel) pleaded guilty under AR 137(A)(5)(a)(ii) in that she used the whip on nine (9) occasions before the 100 metres, which is four (4) more than the permitted number. Jockey Brazil was fined the sum of \$200.

A post race veterinary examination of Fish revealed no obvious abnormalities.

### **RACE 5 – OLIVERS BAKERY ULVERSTONE CLASS 6 HANDICAP – 1175 METRES**

Correct weight was delayed when Jockey B McCoull (Waddington) wished to view the official film. After doing so Jockey McCoull was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Lady Snake lost a hind shoe in the mounting yard. Following consultation with connections and the jockey, when the farrier could not replat the mare Lady Snake underwent a pre race veterinary

examination and was permitted to race bare foot behind. A post race veterinary examination of Lady Snake revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Lady Snake was slow into stride and was unable to muster early speed. Jockey L Coffey reported that the mare slipped for the entire journey.

From the 150 metres to the winning post Speedy Sky wanted to shift out under pressure and as a result Waddington was momentarily inconvenienced.

#### **RACE 6 – KAYE COOK MEMORIAL CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1175 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Smith to ride Gee Gees Truce ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Whiskey Trader pulled hard in the early stages.

#### **RACE 7 – CLAUDE BEST MEMORIAL CLASS 4 HANDICAP – 1175 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey B McCoull to ride Faye Commands ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey M Munday to ride King Of Gondor ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Coffey to ride Alibambi ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Correct weight was delayed when Jockey L Smith (Happent) wished to view the official film over the concluding stages. After doing so Jockey Smith was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Blue Bud and Faye Commands bumped on jumping and as a result Blue Bud was slow to begin.

Stewards questioned Jockey B McCoull about the apparent poor performance of Faye Commands. Jockey McCoull stated that he believed the mare was better suited on softer tracks and when placed under pressure in the home straight failed to respond to his riding. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Mafia Man and Happent bumped on the home turn.

At approximately the 150 metres Happent (L Smith) had to be momentarily steadied off heels when Stormbay Spirit (Y Nishitani (a)) shifted in. Apprentice Nishitani was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

#### **RACE 8 – SPORT OF KINGS EASTER CUP – 2380 METRES**

Correct weight was delayed when Jockey D Pires (Testasaurus) wished to view the official photo of the finish. After doing so Jockey Pires was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Testasaurus and Weaverboy was slow to begin.

At approximately the 2000 metres Mr Reminiscing laid in inconveniencing Weaverboy.

A post race veterinary examination of Weaverboy revealed no obvious abnormalities.
