RACE 1 – TP JONES & CO SUPERVOBIS (TAS) 2YO MAIDEN PLATE- 1100 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Jockey M Guthrie to ride Jay Bee's Gee Gee ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey B McCoull to ride Stylist Spirit ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Jay Bee's Gee Gee reared on jumping and as a result was slow into stride missing the start by 3 lengths.

Approaching the 800 metres Jay Bee's Gee Gee raced ungenerously.

Near the 700 metres Winay Wayna shifted out off the heels of Chipofftheoldblock carrying Jay Bee's Gee Gee wider on the track.

Jockey B McCoull (Stylist Spirit) reported that his mount raced greenly and shifted away from the shadow of the running rail near the 600 metres.

RACE 2 – OLD SCOTCH COLLEGIANS FOOTBALL CLUB 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when Apprentice J Maskiell, rider of the second placegetter Stands To Reason wished to view the official patrol film. After doing so Apprentice Maskiell was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Upon jumping Tal Dean shifted ground outwards abruptly, inconveniencing Holive Hoil and We Say who in turn bumped with Patfull.

El Sunera was slow into stride.

Apprentice R Keogh (Patfull) pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the 800 metres he allowed his mount to shift ground inwards when insufficiently clear of We Say (B McCoull) resulting in that mare being checked and losing its position. Apprentice Keogh was then unable to relieve the pressure due to the fact that El Sunera (B Stanley) had shifted ground inwards before shifting outwards abruptly and being checked by its rider. Stewards deemed the interference and carelessness to be of a moderate level. Apprentice Keogh's licence to ride in races was suspended for 3 Tasmanian race meetings commencing midnight tonight and expiring midnight Sunday 16 May 2010. In arriving at penalty Stewards took into consideration the contributing factors, Apprentice Keogh's honesty during the inquiry and his poor record in relation to this rule.

Approaching the 800 metres El Sunera had to be steadied off the heels of Delz Bells.

Stands To Reason (J Maskiell (a)) laid in near the 100 metres, at the same time El Sunera shifted ground outwards. As a result Stands To Reason was disappointed for a run before shifting ground outwards over the heels of Delz Bells to obtain a clear run. As a result of the shift Patfull (R Keogh (a)) had to be momentarily steadied by its rider. Apprentice Maskiell was advised to exercise far greater care when allowing his mount to shift ground in future.

A post race veterinary examination of La Fete Nationale revealed the gelding to have a wound to the off hind coronet.

RACE 3 – HARCOURTS RURAL SUPERVOBIS (TAS) 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN PLATE – 1400 METRES

Tula was inclined to lay in in the early stages.

Shot Of Fantasy raced three wide in the early and middle stages before taking up a forward position.

RACE 4 – WATER DYNAMICS SHOWCASE MAIDEN/CLASS 1 PLATE – 1600 METRES

Kate's Prospect was slow into stride.

Kate's Prospect contacted the running rail approaching the 1200 metres and was then uncontrollable leaving the 1200 metres, as a result Rayos was hampered and Black Tango was checked and carried wider on the track. Trainer M Doherty was advised that under no circumstances is an inexperienced apprentice to be engaged to ride the gelding in future starts. Trainer Doherty was also advised that Kate's Prospect must trial satisfactorily prior to racing again. Mr Doherty advised Stewards that the gelding will be retired.

Apprentice C Hallett (Princess Sophie) accidentally dropped her whip on the home turn.

A post race veterinary examination of Miss Sophie revealed the mare to be sore in the near fore fetlock. Trainer V Poke was advised that he must submit a veterinary certificate prior to Princess Sophie racing again.

RACE 5 – ACCESS HARDWARE SHOWCASE 0-66 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Raging Baa, Petroleum and No Shadow were all slow into stride.

Green Crusader over raced in the early stages.

Jockey D Parish, when questioned in relation to the apparent disappointing performance of No Shadow, stated that the mare was left flat footed when the pace quickened and she is of the opinion that No Shadow would be better suited over a longer distance. A post race veterinary examination of No Shadow revealed no obvious abnormalities.

A post race veterinary examination of Write It Down revealed the horse to be suffering from "thumps".

RACE 6 – TASMANIAN QUALITY MEATS SHOWCASE CLASS 6 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Jockey K Sanderson to ride Jayzee ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Old Masters was slow into stride.

Jockey L Smith (Zedeshee) pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the 1100 metres he allowed his mount to shift ground inwards when insufficiently clear, making heavy contact with Lantana Lad (J Lambie (a)) resulting in that gelding bumping with I'm Paddy (J Riordan (a)) who in turn brushed with Stormbay Spirit (Y Nishitani (a)). As a result Lantana Lad and I'm Paddy lost their positions. Stewards deemed the interference and carelessness to be of a moderate level. Jockey Smith's licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence midnight Sunday 2 May 2010 and to expire midnight Sunday 9 May 2010.

In arriving at penalty Stewards took into consideration Mr Smith's exemplary record in that he has not been suspended since 2004.

Stewards adjourned an inquiry into the reasons Jayzee (K Sanderson) was tightened and lost its position near the 700 metres.

RACE 7 – GARRY HARPER GARAGE DOORS SHOWCASE CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Trainer B Ryan was advised that a warning has been placed on Light Illusion due to its manners prior to the start.

Mr Fashion and Light Illusion bumped on jumping.

Light Illusion over raced approaching the 1200 metres.

Jockey B McCoull (Mr Fashion) reported that his saddle slipped near the 1100 metres.

Larmar Hall was held up between the 400 and 100 metres before obtaining a clear run.

Jockey D Pires (Rivers Run West) was severely reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the 100 metres he allowed his mount to shift ground inwards when insufficiently clear momentarily inconveniencing the tiring Tawera (B Stanley). Stewards deemed the interference to be of a low level and the carelessness to be of a moderate level. In arriving at penalty Stewards took into consideration Jockey Pires' excellent record with regard to charges under this rule.

Jockey M Guthrie (Lord Aspinall) pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 145 in that he weighed in in excess of ½ kilo over the declared weight. Jockey Guthrie was fined \$200.

RACE 8 – SHELTON BROWN INSURANCE SERVICES SHOWCASE CLASS 4 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Jockey D Pires to ride Rafiq ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey K Sanderson to ride Graceomalli ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey B Stanley to ride Sh'Bourne Kahlua ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Coffey to ride Van Hardyards ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Apprentice R Keogh (Pin Of Hope) was unable to claim any portion of his claim in this race.

Pin Of Hope reared and struck its head on the gates upon jumping.

Near the 400 metres Pin Of Hope had to be momentarily steadied off the heels of King Of Gondor.

A post race veterinary examination of Pin Of Hope revealed no obvious abnormalities.
