**Apprentice Jason Maskiell was examined by the on-course ambulance officers prior to the start of Race 1 and declared fit to fulfil his riding engagements today.**

**\* Jockey M Munday was advised that he must tender a medical clearance before riding in trackwork, trials or races.**

### **RACE 1 – I'M PADDY SUPERVOBIS (TAS) 3YO HANDICAP – 1200 METRES**

Antonine was incorrectly shown as wearing a nose roll when in fact it had been removed when blinkers were added to the mare's Stable Return. A public announcement to this effect was made prior to the start of the race.

Matsangel was hampered upon jumping between Krakeour and Antonine.

Antonine was inclined to lay out in the early and middle stages.

Prince Obama layed in under pressure in the home straight and at approximately the 150 metres momentarily hampered and carried Matsangel in on to Krakeour. Jockey B McCoull was advised to exercise far greater care when allowing his mounts to shift ground in future.

Over the concluding stages Prince Obama shifted ground outwards abruptly.

### **RACE 2 – CAPONE 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN PLATE – SET WEIGHTS – 1200 METRES**

My Wizard underwent a pre race veterinary examination and was passed fit to take its place in the field.

Upon jumping Springfield Jo shifted out abruptly making heavy contact with Dark Rum before shifting ground inwards and unbalancing Jockey Mark Munday. As a result Jockey Munday was dislodged and fell. Jockey M Munday was examined by the on-course ambulance officers and subsequently transported to the Royal Hobart Hospital for precautionary x-rays.

As a result of this incident Vandetta was inconvenienced and lost ground.

Jockey B McCoull stated that Holidays failed to stretch out in the early stages and was then inclined to race greenly.

A post-race veterinary examination of Springfield Jo failed to reveal any abnormalities.

### **RACE 3 – VAN HARDYARDS MAIDEN / CLASS 1 PLATE – SET WEIGHTS – 1600 METRES**

Trustey was inconvenienced at the start when Mugging shifted outwards. As a result Trustey appeared to clip the heels of Roses for Mary and lose its position.

Miss Margate was slow into stride.

Approaching the 1400 metres Aussie Idol shifted ground inwards carrying Inodal Lass in on to Miss Margate which was momentarily hampered.

Roses for Mary raced four wide without cover in the middle stages.

Approaching the 400 metres Miss Margate had to be steadied off the heels of Inodal Lass.

Tawera was inclined to lay in in the home straight. As a result Apprentice C Pace had to stop riding and straighten the gelding on several occasions.

Jockey K Sanderson (Deludor) and Jockey L Coffey (Amazing Pace) stated that both their mounts failed to run out the 1600 metres.

When questioned Trainer G White stated that Amazing Pace will now be sent for a spell. A post-race veterinary examination of Amazing Pace failed to reveal any abnormalities.

### **RACE 4 – STUYVESANT 0-75 HANDICAP – 2100 METRES**

Stadacona, Baby Doe and Testasaurus were all slow into stride.

Stadacona was held up rounding the home turn until approximately the 100 metres.

When questioned on the apparent disappointing performance of Testasaurus, Apprentice N Rose stated that the gelding failed to travel throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed Testasaurus to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer Charlie Goggin was advised that he must tender a veterinary certificate of soundness before Testasaurus' next race start.

A post-race veterinary examination of Write It Down revealed the horse to have a mild case of "Thumps". Trainer Mick Burles was advised that he must tender a veterinary certificate prior to Write It Down's next race start.

### **RACE 5 – DARCENELL CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

Hypothermia became fractious in the barriers. The gelding underwent a pre-race veterinary examination which revealed abrasions over both hocks. Acting on veterinary advice Hypothermia was declared a late scratching at 2.15pm. Prior to the announcement of correct weight, Stewards ordered all monies invested on Hypothermia to be refunded in full and all bets made prior to 2.15pm to be paid less twelve cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less fourteen cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. Stable Foreman Michael Voss was advised that Hypothermia must pass a satisfactory barrier test before racing again.

Rounding the home turn Glamour Legs (NZ) shifted ground outwards brushing with Poacher's Gold.

Jockey M Guthrie (Palzago) reported that his mount felt awkward in its action. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

### **RACE 6 – BETFAIR. COM SUPERVOBIS (TAS) 2YO PLATE – SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS – 1200 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey M Guthrie to ride Aslanyon ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Seeking Chi was hampered at the start between Socks and Dash for Magic.

Aslanyon and Seeking Chi bumped near the 600 metres when Seeking Chi attempted to shift ground outwards.

Apache Chance was inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Jockey D Pires (Tiger Won't Tell) reported that he thought there may have been something amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination of Tiger Won't Tell failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Jockey L Coffey (Apache Chance) stated that he believed the gelding was up in class today and his instructions were to ride forward but in his opinion the gelding would be better suited ridden off the pace. A post-race veterinary examination of Apache Chance failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Apprentice Jason Maskiell (Dash for Magic) stated that after being bumped at the start the colt over reacted and raced ungenerously in amongst other runners and was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn.

As a result of Dash for Magic laying out rounding the home turn, Seeking Chi was momentarily hampered.

#### **RACE 7 – CORAL SEA HANDICAP – 1600 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey D Pires to ride Waddington one kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey B McCoull to ride Speedy Sky ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Coffey to ride Lady Snake ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

White Yard jumped awkwardly and was slow into stride.

Breath Testa was slow into stride.

Speedy Sky lost an off hind plate in running.

When questioned in relation to today's performance of White Yard, Trainer Scott Brunton stated that the mare over-raced in the early stages and due to the early and mid-race pace, was unable to run on. He further stated that the mare would take improvement from today's performance. Trainer Scott Brunton was advised to notify Stewards if anything was found to be amiss with the mare in the coming days.

#### **RACE 8 – BETFAIR.COM FILLIES & MARES HANDICAP – 1200 METRES**

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Coffey to ride Blue Bud one kilogram over its allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Apprentice J Maskiell to ride Emily's Girl ½ kilogram over its allotted weight.

Himstedt was slow into stride and missed the start by approximately two lengths.

Approaching the 200 metres Akamai shifted out marginally brushing with Testamarriage.

Akamai was then inclined to lay in near the 100 metres.

A post-race veterinary examination of Extreme Cost failed to reveal any abnormalities.

#### **RACE 9 – REGAL CHIVAS CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES**

Nothing Surer was unable to muster early speed.

Buck raced four wide without cover throughout.

Montel (NZ) raced three wide without cover throughout.

Jockey L Coffey (Neika Belle) reported that his mount laid on the side of the gates upon jumping and as a result jumped awkwardly and was slow into stride.

Apprentice C Hallett (Bonableu) reported that her mount hung out severely throughout the event and in her opinion, there may have been something amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination

of Bonableu failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer Andrew Roach was advised that due to the gelding's manners Bonableu must trial satisfactorily before racing again.
