RACE 1 – BOAGS PREMIUM MAIDEN/CLASS 1 PLATE – 1800 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when the Apprentice C Pace (Trustey) wished to view the film over the concluding stages. After doing so he was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Trustey was fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

Captainmacgaw shifted out upon jumping hampering Here's Shifty.

Baccarat Boy over raced in the early stages due to the slow pace.

Approaching the 1100 metres Captainmacgaw began to over race and shifted ground outwards momentarily hampering Here's Shifty.

Captainmacgaw laid in in the home straight and over the concluding stages brushed with Trustey which had shifted ground outwards.

Jockey D Pires (Here's Shifty) reported that his horse didn't handle the track conditions today.

Jockey D Pires pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 83(a) misconduct in that on return to the mounting yard he made inappropriate comments while dismounting. Stewards deemed the misconduct to be of a moderate level and when arriving at penalty took into consideration the area where the comments were made and the particulars of the comments. Jockey Pires was subsequently fined \$400.

RACE 2 – SHAW CONTRACTING 2YO MAIDEN PLATE – 1000 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Jockey B McCoull to ride Dosh Dash ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey D Pires to ride Nicole'slilmiss ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Franklin And Main was slow into stride. Apprentice Y Nishitani stated that his mount raced greenly throughout. A post race veterinary examination revealed the filly to have lacerations to the inside hind cannons and pasterns.

Stylist Spirit was momentarily steadied near the 500 metres when racing tight to the inside of Shinto which was carried inwards by Nicole'slilmiss.

Jockey B McCoull (Dosh Dash) reported that the filly raced ungenerously throughout.

RACE 3 – TOTAL CARE 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN PLATE – 1000 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Miss Amiamour to race without hoof pads today. Miss Amiamour underwent a pre race veterinary examination and was passed fit to take her place in the field.

Fev's Girl underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers which revealed a minor tongue laceration and was passed fit to take her place in the field.

Wills Hope was inconvenienced at the start when Fev's Girl shifted inwards.

Wills Hope (J Lambie (a)) was inclined to over race in the early and middle stages and approaching the 600 metres had to be steadied by its rider.

Apprentice C Hallett (Nats Ticketty) was reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the 500 metres she allowed her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of Hot Sybil (K Sanderson) which was inconvenienced in onto Leica Legend (D Pires).

Rubio tailed the field throughout. A post race veterinary examination of Rubio revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer G McCulloch was advised that the mare must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again.

RACE 4 – GRANGEMOORE PARK 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN PLATE – 1175 METRES

Indica was declared a late scratching at 12.12 pm due to the unavailability of a suitable rider.

Decimedes reared in the barriers prior to the start.

Decimedes, West Lunar and Grills were all slow into stride.

RACE 5 – SIMONS CARPET ONE 0-66 HANDICAP – 1800 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Coffey to ride Van Hardyards ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Jaytee reared in the barriers prior to the start.

Jaytee was inclined to over race mid race.

Nuvolari was inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Stewards questioned Apprentice J Lambie in relation to the riding instructions on Jaytee. Apprentice Lambie was of the opinion that the instructions were to lead and was not aware that Trainer Crook did not wish to have the horse restrained.

RACE 6 – SEBA SHEETMETAL CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1175 METRES

Gazumper and Mini Mollie were both slow into stride.

Mini Mollie tailed the field throughout. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer K Simpson was advised that Mini Mollie must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again.

Trainer L Wells advised Stewards that Millow will be spelled following the filly's performance today.

A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have soft palate displacement. Trainer T Roles advised Stewards that Gazumper will be retired immediately.

Jockey B McCoull (Neika Belle) reported that something felt amiss with the mare today. A post race veterinary examination revealed the mare was suffering from atrial fibrillation. Trainer J Clifford was

advised that he must produce a veterinary certificate including an ECG report following a track gallop before Neika Belle races again.

RACE 7 – FAY’S JEWELLERS DIAMOND BRACELET SPRINT – 1000 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Jockey K Sanderson to ride Beven Heights ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey L Smith to ride Zedeshee ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Correct weight was delayed when Apprentice C Hallett rider of the second placegetter, Jackmelad wished to view the official films. After doing so Apprentice Hallett lodged a protest against the winner Heartbreak Kid (S Maskiell) alleging interference over the final 100 metres. After taking evidence from all parties Stewards DISMISSED the protest as they could not be satisfied that the interference suffered was greater than the margin at the finish. It was established that after making the crossing near the 200 metres both mounts gradually shifted ground outwards and at approximately the 80 metres Heartbreak Kid brushed with Jackmelad.

Old Masters and Maywyns Quest were both slow into stride.

Blue Bud laid in under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 8 – OLIVERS BAKERY ULVERSTONE CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1175 METRES

Cool Illusion over raced in the early stages.

Jockey S Maskiell (Royal Oncology) was reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the 500 metres he allowed his mount to shift ground inwards momentarily hampering Flash Lad (B McCoull) before relieving the pressure.

Autumn Sun performed below market expectations. Jockey L Coffey and Trainer J Clifford could offer no explanation for today’s performance. A post race veterinary examination of Autumn Sun revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Trainers G McCulloch, J Luttrell, S & D Brunton, M Everett and V Rhind were each fined \$50 under AR 80C in that they left their horses unattended at a race meeting in the stripping stall area.
